The Department of Public Works has begun a sanitary sewer main replacement for Monroe Avenue. This project was funded by the Monroe County Community Development Block Grant. It consists of approximately 800' of 10" sanitary sewer main replacement down the middle of Monroe Avenue, from Utica Street to Main Street.

While excavating, it will be necessary to have the street closed in this area during construction hours only. We will make every attempt possible to get the occupants that live in that stretch from their homes without delay. Please keep in mind that we may have to move heavy equipment to get you through and your patience during this process will be appreciated.

After the sewer and manhole are replaced we will be doing restoration work down the middle. We will schedule a milling machine to mill the entire street, including the curbs. We will be installing concrete curbs and then repaving the street.
