

PARKING

The Brockport Police wants to remind the public about parking ordinances in the Village of Brockport. No vehicles can be parked on any village street from the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. every day. A vehicle also cannot block any village sidewalk or any driveway.

For village parking lots, follow the following code:

- On Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, between the hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. no vehicle can be parked in the parking lot between King Street and Erie Street, the West lot (Side closest to Main Street) on Water Street, and in front of the Welcome Center located at 11 Water Street.
- On Tuesday and Thursday between the hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. no vehicles can be parked in the parking lot South of Erie Street (Parking Lot of the Frontier Tower), the South side lot on Water Street, the Market Street lot (Brockport Fire Department lot), East lot North of Water Street, and the 1 Clinton Street lot (Brockport Police Department lot).
