

**Canalfront Hospitality Program
Village of Brockport**

Fee Schedule and Occupancy Rules

Boaters intending to stay overnight at the canal wall in Brockport with access to the Village facilities (electricity, water, Welcome Center) will be expected to pay the following fees per 24-hour period:

Boat length in feet	Fee
Under 10	\$4.00
10to 19	\$6.00
20 to 29	\$8.00
30 to 39	\$12.00
40 and over	\$15.00

Commercial boats will pay \$20.00 per night. Rowboats, canoes, and kayaks will pay no fee.

No reservations will be taken, except for commercial boats. Checkout time is 2:00 p.m. Boaters staying more than one night will pay for each succeeding night before the Welcome Center closes. If all canal wall berths are occupied and additional boats arrive by 2:00 p.m., boats that have occupied space more than two days may be required to vacate the dock in order of length of occupancy. Rafting is permitted.

Under NYS Canal Corporation regulations, boats may be tied up at the canal wall for no more than 48 hours in any month without charge or permit, if the boaters do not request access to the Village facilities. Stays longer than 48 hours require a Canal Corporation permit.
