Please take notice – BISCO, Brockport Integrated Service and Community Organization, will be holding its annual Brockport Arts Festival on Saturday, August 12th and Sunday, August 13th. Feel free to check out their information on the reverse side of this letter.

New York State Department of Transportation issued a special use permit authorizing the following **street closure from 7pm Friday, August 11th to 7pm Sunday, August 13th:**

- **Main Street (NYS Rt. 19) from Clark Street to the Adams Street / Park Avenue / Fair Street intersection**

Additionally, the Brockport Village Board authorized the following:

- **Main Street ends of the following side streets: Clinton, King, Erie, Holley, Monroe, College, South, Union, State, Market, Water – will be limited to local and vendor access. Barricades will be placed to limit the side streets to local traffic only with no admittance to Main Street.**
- **Please be advised that the “Cruise-In” will occupy College Street 10am-5pm Sunday.**

Main Street and all side streets will re-open on Sunday, August 13th at 7pm.

BISCO’s festival information is enclosed. Please follow any traffic detours or parking regulations as appropriate. Thank you for your cooperation. Enjoy the festival!
