Members present: Appleby, Donovan, Fox, Kristansen, CEO Zamstorff

- Discussion about the idea of putting teeth in our vehicle and traffic laws, especially parking. State law seems to indicate that we can not threaten jail time for non-payment of parking tickets. We can suspend licenses and registrations for traffic infractions. We will have to talk to the police chief and the attorney.
- The college has a process for dealing with other bad behaviors, as well as parking tickets that students get on campus. Perhaps we could tie into that for students that get parking tickets in the village.
- Discussion about parking pass proposal, specifically trucks of more than one ton. Our revised parking code says up to one ton. Should we ask them to get a special permit or just give them tickets? We could change our draft code to allow higher tonnage, or just take it out. We may need to add commercial vehicles to the pass proposal, where tonnage will certainly become an issue. Trucks would also have to fit into a 10'x20' space, per our code. Also in Ch. 34, Scott states that we need to remove references to fire hydrants, as they are covered in vehicle and traffic as well as state law.
- Discussion about bagsters – Scott is working on getting Waste Management to come and talk to us at a regular meeting. We might consider asking them to change the design of the bagster to give it flaps to close, or just their instructions asking users not to leave them uncovered at the curb. Scott suggests that they should have a permit in order to be placed at the curb, just like a dumpster.
- Scott reminded us that the new FOIL law takes effect on 2-2-12
