Bird Feeders – Pam Ketchum brought up the fact that some business owners have bird feeders which are making quite a mess on Main Street. As was discussed at the March 19<sup>th</sup> meeting there will be no bird feeders allowed on Main Street (in the historic commercial district).

Western Monroe Historical Society – The 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of WMHS is being celebrated this year. There is a talk at the Morgan Manning House tonight. A Victorian Tea is being held there on April 12<sup>th</sup>.

Low Bridge High Water – The 3<sup>rd</sup> annual LBHW events will occur May 14-16<sup>th</sup>, most of the events along the canal in the Village. The May 14<sup>th</sup> event is a talk by Tom Grasso at the Morgan Manning House.
