

**Village of Brockport
Historic Preservation Board
Meeting
June 19, 2014**

Call to order: 7:15

Attendance: Bill Andrews, Sri Ram Bakshi, Kathy Goetz, Pam Ketchum, Kevin McCarthy, Jackie Morris, Tiffany Rawling

Public Hearing: 7:20pm Hearing was called to consider the proposed nominations of 51 Park Avenue, 300 Main Street, and 52 State Street as Local Landmarks. No comments were offered by the public. A motion was made by P. Ketchum, 2nd by J. Morris to approve the nomination of these houses as local landmarks. All were in favor.

Approval of minutes: 7:30pm May 15, 2014 A motion was made by B. Andrews, 2nd by K. McCarthy, all approved the minutes.

Approval of Sign: Mr. and Mrs. Ken Reid were present to discuss the sign to be placed on the Post Office to honor their son, St. Sergeant Nicholas A. Reid. After considered discussion, it was felt that a simple bronze plaque to be mounted on the building would be most appropriate. The decision as to location will be left to them and the post office. Pam will be the liaison for this.

Old Business:

Website - An e-mail was received from Clinton Brown stating that the website is now in our hands. Pam Ketchum asked if there was any move to have this site become part of the Village website. Kevin McCarthy noted that the summer is a very busy time and that he will look into that in the fall.

60 Clinton Street - At this time Greg O'Connell is unable to pursue the project due to illness. Jo Matela is applying for a grant to assist in securing a consultant.

Progress on NY Main Street Grant - The committee is working with the 10 building owners. Each will receive a subsidy of 60%. July 9th is the deadline for the work plan. Pam Ketchum has delivered copies of the information to each merchant.

Progress on the State & National Nomination - Kathy Goetz & Pam Ketchum met with Katie Eggars-Comeau and her photographic intern, discussed the project and walked the designated area on State Street and Park Avenue. They had planned to begin the paperwork just after our meeting. Bill Andrews stated that the owners of the RR Depot are being uncooperative and that it will not be included in the project.

Yo Twister Sign approval - The material is alright but the script and colors must look Victorian. It could be hung perpendicular. B. Andrews and P. Ketchum will deal with it.

The Creative Inking sign is very nice and is up.

BI/CEO Dave Miller has made a suggestion to streamline the approval process. It sounds efficient and would be something that would be good to discuss with him. It was suggested that we meet with him after he is finished at the office so that he would not have to drive back for an evening meeting.

New Business:

Training Manual Chapter 4 - The Board reviewed this.

It was noted that NYS has recommended 28 sites including Eric Canal with many sites along it route to the State & National Register.

Pam Ketchum noted that Pro-Brockport is encouraging people to do murals at 60 Clinton Street.
