

**Village of Brockport
Historic Preservation Board

September 18, 2014**

Call to order: 7:15pm

Present:

The 8/21/14 HPB meeting was cancelled.

Old Business:

60 Clinton Street – W. Andrews shared that he spoke to developer Greg O’Connell who is in Geneseo recuperating from a health issue. He is still interested in 60 Clinton Street.

Main Street Grant – W. Andrews and P. Ketchum reported on the progress of the Main Street Revitalization project. LaBella Associates will provide the required environmental report.

Progress on the State & National Nomination – P. Ketchum, K. Goetz, C. Hannan met with Katie Eggers-Comeau of Bero Architecture to discuss the houses which she felt did not meet National Register criteria. While they may not meet the structural criteria, they were homes of important figures in Brockport’s history and it was felt they should be recognized as such. K. Eggers-Comeau agreed to submit the report without declaring them non-compliant and to see what Virginia Bartos’s response will be. V. Bartos may want to meet with the HPB regarding this.

W. Andrews reported that Cynthia Howk of the Landmark Society has begun work on the nomination of High Street Cemetery.

BI/CEO – Since it has been difficult to find a time that new BI/CEO D. Miller can attend an HPB meeting, they will wait until he is finished with the majority of the initial work he is doing.

Reappointment – HPB feels that Pam Ketchum should be reappointed to the vacancy.

New Business:

Historic Mural – Walk Bike Brockport & Pro-Brockport are organizing the painting of a historic mural at Sagawa Park.

Training Manual – Chapter 5 was reviewed and each member was encouraged to study each of the chapters in the manual.
