

**MINUTES**  
**HOUSING TASK FORCE MEETING**  
**OCTOBER 12, 2015**

**Attendees: Martie, Skip, Val, Pam, Marcy**

**Unable to attend: Kathy, David, Mike**

- 1. Minutes of 8/25/15 and 9/22/15 meetings were voted on and approved, with one change, each**
- 2. Discussion on holding meetings, starting in 2016, on the same day of the week. 2015 meeting dates will remain as is (10/12, 10/27, 11/9, 11/24, 13/14, 12/22) Decision is to hold the 2016 meetings on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month, pending Martie confirming this with Leslie Morelli.**
- 3. A Village of Brockport Summary of Garbage Pickup document from 2006 was presented, in addition to discussing the Modern Disposal's bid for Orleans County Curbside Collection and Removal of Refuse, Garbage, and Recyclables, 2010, document that Skip had provided to task force members at the 9/22/15 meeting.**

**Further review of these documents is needed on the part of task force members. If you don't have a copy of the Modern document, please ask for one. Val said that she will email the 2006 Brockport document as an attachment, via email to task force members; it is too large of a document to make several copies of.**

**It is necessary for each member to review these documents before submitting a request for bid(s) to the Village Board.**

**Martie expressed that there is no need to "reinvent the wheel" when these documents are at our disposal and can be**

**used as a guide for us to use when preparing what to submit to the Village Board. Others expressed their opinions that maybe this is a waste of time pursuing. Others felt that it is well worth it.**

**(Note from Secretary: It is my humble opinion that any vote taken regarding this issue, should include every member of the task force, not just who is at a particular meeting. All votes should include all members of the committee.)**

**4. It was noted that the Comptroller's Office of the State of NY put together the Study of Residential Refuse Collection, 2005-2006.**

**5. It was also noted that David Miller can provide such information as: # of households, # of residents/household, etc.**

**Categories: residential, commercial.**

**Same consistency for all, with one provider.**

**This one service for all would solve the problem of people collecting their own garbage.**

**Most important is how refuse collections effect the value of property and quality of life.**

**Pickup dates would be set/section of the village, (a specific day of the week/section).**

**6. HTF members are asked to review the document that Val will email to the group, as well as the Modern document and to ask themselves – what would be different now, from that past study?**
