- 1. Mike DeClerk – “we feel very strongly about the model – what is the pulse of the community?  
Victor studied this last year – 80% of the residents did not want this.  
Martie – ‘if we did this, there would be a big educational component involved’.**
- 2. Martie – Modern has a very good reputation  
In Orleans County, there are 3 providers – Modern, WM, and Republic. Small, independent haulers lose in this model.**
- 3. Mike DeClerk – As a company, competition is good.  
“We’re viewed as a giant merchant.”  
It is important to talk with the private, small haulers, to have a sensitivity to the smaller companies.**
- 4. Brockport has 1,371 single family residences; 369 rentals.  
Currently, W/M, Suburban, and Youngblood service Brockport’s waste disposal needs.  
Dissemination of information; polling of residents needed.**
- 5. Val (W/M) – chances are, some of the smaller providers now servicing Brockport, would no longer be in Brockport; the impact could be huge.  
- David Miller can provide info. on all haulers in Brockport.  
- Suggestion – reduce the amount of days each hauler is in**

**the village.**

- **Garbage companies haven't had the opportunity to recover from the days of local dumps – to the change to garbage and recycling services.**
- **Recycling – has become more supply than demand.**
- **Houses with 10-20 people would be a dumpster model.**
