1. David shared a draft of a letter that he prepared, to residents of Fair Street, re: traffic flow and on-street parking.

Discussion followed, re: damage done to village streets by school busses, large vehicles (ambulance, fire trucks, delivery trucks), etc.

2. Martie said that she spoke with the Police Chief, Fire Chief, Ambulance Corps, about the possibility of Fair Street being made a one-way street. The Ambulance Corps wants to wait until May 1st, when they are relocated there, to address this. The Fire Chief is going to investigate – he definitely feels this changes things. The Police Chief wants to be proactive rather than reactive about potential problems with the relocation.

Mike is in favor of making Fair Street one-way, going east

3. Martie asked – Is a public hearing necessary? Answer: yes it is.

4. On the questionnaire, ask “do you prefer one-way with on-street parking, or, two ways and no on-street parking.

5. Upon review of suggested updates/additions to the Dear Resident Letter, we, as a committee, will approve or disapprove it by email. Mike moved to accept this way voting; Annie seconded it.
