HOUSING TASK FORCE MEETING

7-2-18; 5:30 p.m.

- 1. The minutes of our 3/26/18 and 5/21/18 meetings were voted on and approved.**
- 2. College Neighborhood Plans were discussed. It was noted that the Cortland Plan has not been adopted yet.**
- 3. No more conversions of homes from single to multi, student housing was mentioned**
- 4. Code Enforcement – two (2) new code enforcement officers need to be hired. Currently, the Clarkson CEO is working part-time for Brockport**
- 5. The new assessor (village) looked at all 3 ways that they can look at a house and the higher # is what they were assessed at**
- 6. A representative from Ingalls Planning and Design will attend our next meeting. He also wants to meet with Chuck and Skip, who are on the committee for the Comprehensive Plan**
- 7. NE Gateway and Clinton Corridor Enhancement Initiative: Brockport already has trees, bike lanes, crosswalks, sidewalks**
- 8. Question – Can residents pay to ride the College bus, now that it's privately run (answer: probably not). [Note: Annie Crane has since inquired about this and the answer is "no".] The College bus pretty much covers the whole village The Transit Authority may discontinue it's run to Brockport**
- 9. The idea of making the Village Co-Terminus, as the Town was discussed, i.e. make parts of Sweden and Clarkson a part of Brockport.**
