Discussed:

- Composition and purpose of the Task Force
- Brockport Police role in addressing code-related issues when they pose acute health and safety concerns
- Code enforcement team's priority plan; if it is focused on expired Certificates of Occupancy, question how to achieve labor-intensive responses to other code-related issues (e.g. garbage, furniture on porches, etc.); is there a Village Board charge or expectation for a specific response time for code-related complaints from the community.
- Potential role of the Village Court in code enforcement; question of legal consequences of property owner failure to maintain code and respond to official code citations.; question of real estate/protery law that determines consequence of failure of code compliance.
- Jamie would look into possibility of College at Brockport faculty/student interest in making Geographic Information Systems (GIS) maps of Village property and code violations.

Agreed again to review Village Board Meeting minutes for residents' comments about housing and quality of life in the Village; review chapter 58-35 of the village Code.
