
**February 10, 2015, 7:00 p.m., - Meeting with Andy Pleninger
re Contract for Services – Urban Forest Management Plan
and Brockport Village Tree Board Objectives/Plan**

Members Present:

General Discussion began with Andy asking for any edits or questions on the Contract for Services he proposed to the Tree Board. There were few edits and Andy said he would make corrections and resubmit a corrected copy to Ian who can pass it along to other members.

Margay said she would contact Harry Donohue of the DPW to attend our future meetings on the Management Plan. Since Harry did not attend this evening and few members were able to attend, the discussion was limited to general requirements of the grant, management plan, and objectives of the Tree Board members.

Andy made the following recommendations:

- The Tree Board members need to discuss and formulate their objectives to be accomplished within the Management Plan.
- A timetable needs to be set with deadlines established within which the Plan can accomplish its purposes.
- The objectives and Plan need to be shared with DPW, and any other stakeholders such as SUNY, the Parks Committee, utility companies.
- The possibility of a History of the Village Trees to be created. Margay said she would enjoy putting this together.

The evening was then completed with a demonstration by Andy of the Urforian.com website, which affords us to view the trees surveyed/tree inventory in the village. Margay has been granted access to be able to go into it, and Andy added Ian in to have access to it as well.

The **next regular meeting of the Tree Board is Tuesday, February 24, 2015**, a change due to the third Tuesday being impacted by its' falling within the Winter Break week when maybe some members will be away.

To be considered at that Regular Meeting is whether additional Management Plan discussions/meetings could be incorporated into future regular monthly meetings, rather than separate meetings.
