Re: NYCOM Public Works School

Below you will see my summary of the Public Works School that I attended last month. It was put on by NYCOM and held at the Ramada Inn in Geneva N.Y. The conference started on Sunday October 16th, 2016 and ended on Wednesday October 19th, 2016.

Upon arriving Sunday October 16th and checking in with NYCOM, I had the pleasure to walk through the Vendor display area and talked & looked at various new products & displays the vendors had out. I then proceeded to the Welcoming dinner put on by NYCOM. Mayor James Miccio from Fishkill & NYCOM's First Vice President gave the opening remarks & welcomed everyone to Public Works School.

On Monday, October 17th, Being the early riser that I am I first attended a buffet breakfast with several Superintendents from around Monroe County. I then proceeded to the first class titled MS4 Stormwater Permit Requirements. Being familiar with this area I decided to attend this session to see if there have been any significant changes since I last attended any County Stormwater meetings. The speaker was Mary Rossi an Environmental Compliance Specialist from Erie County. She spoke a lot about pollution prevention & good housekeeping for municipal operations and Public Works facilities. Most of our DPW facility is in very good shape, however there are always areas that could use improvements. She had brought with her many pictures of good and not so good facilities that she inspected throughout Erie County. This class had many good points and ideas on how to remedy problems at any DPW compounds.

Later that morning I attended a class titled Wage and Hour Laws. The speaker of this class was attorney John Corcoran from the firm Partner, Hancock, Estabrook LLP. In his class he covered many State & Federal wage & hour laws, rules & regulations. Some of the information that he provided we do not have to abide by because we have a negotiated contract with DPW employees. The contract would supersede some of the rules & regulations. Some of the class touched on Comp time and other perks. Mr. Corcoran seemed to be very up to date with his information and answered all the questions given to him from other Supt's & Board members. This class was well worth my time spent listening to Mr. Corcoran.

I then attend the luncheon provided by NYCOM at the Hotel. Following the luncheon, I attended a class called Innovations in Asphalt. The guest speaker was Bruce Barkevich VP of NY Construction Materials association. This class was probably the most informative class I attended all day. It dealt with the advancing changes in the asphalt industry. Mr. Barkevich is very involved with every quarry in NYS and spoke of their different products both good ones and bad ones. We are very fortunate to have a couple of the best stone quarries in the state according to him. The quality of stone is one of the determining factors in how well a paved road holds up. As he put it we are not dealing with hot rocks and oil any more. Today both the oil & stones are put through extensive engineering and testing to make sure the final product holds up for the long haul. This class was well worth my time.

Following the classes there was a Vendor reception in the ball room and then it was off to dinner with Superintendents from our association (WNYVSA). As I am the treasurer for this association I had the credit card for dinner. We had a few Vendors tag along with us as well.

Beginning on Tuesday October 18th, I again attended the early morning breakfast buffet held under a tent on the Hotel property along the shore of Seneca lake. It was a beautiful morning watching the sun come up over the hills down there.

Following breakfast, the first session I attended was called Understanding & Using the MUTCD (Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices) Kenneth Swain was the guest speaker. He is a circuit rider from the Cornell Local Roads program. This session identified the requirements & responsibilities for using and understanding the MUTCD. It also touched on engineering studies & judgements applicable while using the MUTCD. The MUTCD also has a NYS supplement that supersedes the National manual on certain signs. You must look at both when determining what and where a sign will go. This class was a good refresher for me as I am somewhat familiar with the Manual and refer to it many times throughout the year for signage.

I then attended a session on Municipal streetlight conversion: Financial & Technical considerations. The moderator was George Woodbury from Lightsmart Energy Consulting. The speaker was Pat Courtney Strong President of Courtney Strong, Inc. In this session they talked about converting street lights to LED's. Mr. Woodbury has done many of these conversions on the east coast from Georgia all the way to Boston. Although he talked about the Hudson Valley & Westchester area it was still interesting to listen to. He also talked about how you should plan for the maintenance of the LED's after the conversion. I picked up pointers once we do our conversion. I also have the contact information for George if we run into any snags once we get our lighting infrastructure underway. He seems very willing to help on that end. Another great session attended.

After lunch I attended class on Underground Damage Prevention. The speaker was Chris Flaherty from Dig Safely New York. I have known Chris since he started with DSNY. He actually lives in Churchville and covers all of Western NY as the field rep. His presentation focused on work habits & procedures that equipment operators should follow to help eliminate damage to buried underground facilities. It is very important for anyone to contact DSNY whenever they are going to do any digging including with a hand shovel. I also had the opportunity to talk with Chris about our grid area that we get stakeout requests from. He stopped out late last week to help us narrow up our grid area so we don't continue to get requests for Sweden & Clarkson. Another well attended refresher class on underground excavating. On a side note DSNY holds a seminar in March at Burgundy Basin Inn. I usually send at least half of my crew to it so they can obtain firsthand information from DSNY. That evening I attended a dinner with other Superintendents as well as some of the Vendors.

On Wednesday October 19th, I went to the wonderful buffet breakfast again under the tent on the lake. I then attended the Early-Riser Roundtable Discussion. The room sat 40 and was packed full with about 2 dozen standing. Most were there to express concern about the next years rumor that NYCOM school was going to be held in Binghamton. I attended as the Treasurer of the W.N.Y.V.S.A. (Western New York Village Superintendents Association) along with our President Tom West from Spencerport DPW & Vice President Steve Farrell from Scottsville DPW to offer a monetary amount to NYCOM to help fund & ensure future schools. They have lost a lot of attendance over the years at the Public Works Schools. We are hoping to help them build up attendance again. This year school only had 64 superintendents in attendance. There were 52 individuals that were board members or other DPW staff for a total of 116 attendees. A far cry from over 544 Villages in New York.

Overall I am thankful for the support from the Mayor and the Board for allowing me the opportunity to attend the NYCOM school this year. If there are any questions regarding any of the sessions that I attended, I would be glad to discuss it with them.
