No public comment on anything other than the evening's topic.



Tom Terwilliger, Aaron Gray, Barry Shaver for The Red Jug Pub. They are partners. B. Shaver is the Manager and lives on West Avenue in Clarkson. They hope to open in June. They will have 38 beers on tap and will emphasize craft beers. They are currently hiring and will have 35 to 40 employees. They have 30 to 35 employees at their Cortland location. They need more here because more security is needed in a stand-alone building. Security has New York State DMV and SLA security licenses. They will be Red Jug employees so they can do additional training. They will have video cameras inside and out. Occupancy is 190+. There will be a sprinkler system. DPW will be running the water line to it. The exterior of the building will be painted brick red. Parking was discussed and is minimal – 7 spaces. They emphasized walkability to the bar. Line up outside was discussed and they will use theater ropes and have line rules such as no foul language, no pushing. Possible late night shuttle bus was discussed which they have at their Oneonta and Cortland locations. They have been talking with Jimmy Zisovski of Jimmy Z's who is organizing funding a late night shuttle bus that would run until 3am. Village Board suggested they might try partnering with the College. They mentioned a wish list for the Village and the New York State Canal Corp would be for a sidewalk, sufficient lighting, and canal wall repair.
