Section 25.1 Health Insurance

Current Language:

D. Effective June 1, 2017 all employees enrolled in Village sponsored health insurance plans will have deducted from their biweekly paycheck 5.00% of the monthly premiums.

Change Language by adding at the start of the section:

D. Effective January 1, 2017 all employees enrolled in Village sponsored health insurance plans will have deducted from their biweekly paycheck 2.50% of the monthly premiums.

Section 25.1 Health Insurance:

Add new section:

G. The Village agrees to pay members for any costs over the applicable deductible indicated as "out of pocket expenses" up to the listed "out of pocket maximum" for medical expenses, not prescription or vision.


