

Special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brockport was held in the Conference Room, Municipal Building, 49 State Street, Brockport, New York, June 13, 2010 at 6:00pm.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Castañeda called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Closing of the Water Street parking lot for use by the Farmer's Market -

→ Motion by Deputy Mayor Martin, second by Mayor Castañeda, unanimously carried 3/0 that the Village parking lot located adjacent to the north side of Water Street be closed from 3 a.m. through 3 p.m. each Sunday from June 20, 2010 through October 31, 2010.

Hiring of 2 seasonal DPW laborers – inadvertently omitted during the previous regular Board meeting –

→ Motion by Deputy Mayor Martin, second by Trustee Blair, unanimously carried 3/0 to authorize the hiring of the two seasonal DPW laborers as proposed by DPW Superintendent Donahue: Matthew Hess and David Saeva at \$7.25 per hour 40 hours per week through August 31, 2010.

Trustee Blair shared the information he had obtained from his meeting with one of their Board Members.

Discussion concerning the Ambulance Corps travel request to the EMS Vital Signs conference in NYC - More to follow.
