 - New York Main Street Grant Program – 2013 consolidated funding application – Focus to be on Main Street Historic Commercial District from King Street to the Canal and from Market Street to the Canal. Board ok with Clerk modifying letter for Mayor’s signature inviting said property owners to an informational meeting Thursday, 5/23/13 at 7pm at Village Hall.
 - Walk!Bike!Brockport! – BISCO Grant Committee – safe routes to schools and playgrounds - Dr. Jim Goetz is chairing this subcommittee of Walk Bike Brockport towards a \$10,000 grant for greater safety for school children. One item is to considering lowering the speed limit - determined best handled by better enforcing the existing speed limit.
