- ***Keep limbs under 10ft in length.***
- ***Do not place between poles or signs.***
- ***Do not place brush in road.***

For items other than brush you should contact your refuse hauler.

**LEAF PICKUP WILL BEGIN AS NEEDED UNTIL THE FIRST SIGNIFICANT
SNOWFALL.**

Please leave piled leaves between the sidewalk and/or the curblineline. Leaves only, no rubbish. **Do not place leaves in the road.** Bagging not required; if you wish to bag your leaves please place in paper bags only. Plastic will not be accepted.

NOTICE TO BROCKPORT RESIDENTS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that WATER MAIN FLUSHING in the Village of Brockport will take place October 8th-10th.

As part of our routine maintenance of the water distribution system in the Village, Department of Public Works crews will be flushing water mains on **October 8-10, 2024**. We do this periodically to clean the mains and flush out sediment accumulations that may settle out in the mains. The flushing will ensure that you have a safe and healthy supply of drinking water.

Flushing operations will be conducted between 9:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. in the following locations on the date indicated:

Tuesday, October 8, 2024:
NORTH of the canal.
All hydrants, EAST
of North Main Street (NYS Route 19)

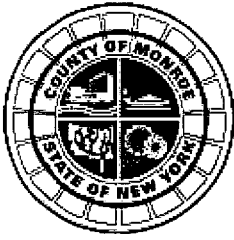
Tuesday, October 8, 2024:
NORTH of the canal.
All hydrants WEST of North Main Street.

Wednesday October 9, 2024:
SOUTH of the canal
All hydrants EAST of Main Street

Thursday, October 10, 2024:
SOUTH of canal
All hydrants WEST of Main Street.

During flushing you may see some cloudiness or color in the water. Please do not use any unnecessary water during this period. The flushing may cause the water to become "cloudy" or "discolored". While the water will be safe to drink, we suggest that you do not wash clothes if you notice the water is discolored. **ANYONE ON A KIDNEY DIALYSIS MACHINE, PLEASE CALL THE SUPERINTENDENTS OFFICE AT THE NUMBER BELOW!**

We have received cannabis tax collections for the 2nd quarter 2024, in accordance with the State's reporting period, that are primarily a result of cannabis sales during the period of March 1, 2024 through May 31, 2024. Your village's share of the Second Quarter 2024 cannabis tax receipts is \$2,417.38.

A copy of this letter has been sent to your Village Treasurer. The payment for this quarter representing your village's distribution has been made via ACH transfer.

Please note, if the New York State Taxation and Finance Department, through its auditing process, uncovers any discrepancies with this quarter's reported amount, the figures may be adjusted thereby affecting future quarterly reporting periods.
