The Brockport Welcome Center is open during the canal navigation season, seven days a week, mid-May to mid-October. Volunteer shifts are for 2 hours, once a week, bi-weekly or as substitutes. Some responsibilities for volunteers include registering overnight guests, check-in/out our bike loans, offering directions and recommendations to community amenities, and monitoring activities along the waterfront. Training and support are provided, and assistance is always available.

Our facility is fully accessible and volunteers ages 16 or older are encouraged to explore the possibilities of becoming an Ambassador for Brockport.
