Dear Congressman Morelle:

I am writing this letter as an indication of my strong support for our request for sewer infrastructure funding through the Community Project appropriations process. Through this project, our Department of Public Works will reconstruct approximately 1,940 linear feet of sewer lines throughout the Village to enhance our infrastructure's safety, reliability, and performance. A local assessment of our sewer infrastructure revealed that many of the lines (all of which are 70 or 100 years old) have significant defects, including cracked lines, breaking tiles, tree root growth in pipes, and groundwater infiltration, and will soon become entirely unserviceable without major work. Therefore, it is critical to complete the proposed project to keep our sewer infrastructure in working order, preserve the health and wellbeing of residents and visitors, maintain property values for both homeowners and business owners, and ensure that Brockport's residents do not have to bear the burden of potential sewer blockages or backups.

This project will link directly to our municipality's mission, which is to provide a high quality of life for all residents while exercising fiscal responsibility and preserving Brockport's unique heritage and historic character. Ensuring that we can offer our residents a safe and reliable infrastructure is one of our key goals, and completing this project will play a large role in meeting it. As a result, I am offering my full support for our Community Project Funding request.
