

**VILLAGE OF BROCKPORT
NOTICE OF TENTATIVE BUDGET FILING
& PUBLIC HEARING**

Please take notice that on behalf of the Mayor, the Treasurer of the Village of Brockport filed with the Village Clerk the Tentative Budget of said Village for the fiscal year beginning June 1, 2023. It is available from the Village website at www.brockportny.org or for review at Village Hall during normal business hours.

The tentative budget includes:

Projected General Fund revenues & expenditures: \$6,674,589

Compensation proposed to be paid elected officials as follows:

Mayor \$11,567 / year	(0% change from last year)
Trustees (4) at \$4,674 / year	(0% change from last year)
Village Justice (2) at \$17,400 / year	(0% change from last year)

Proposed tax rate: \$11.13/1,000 of assessed valuation.

Last year's tax rate \$11.75/1,000 of assessed valuation.

The tentative budget will increase the tax levy by 9.78% and a vote to override the tax cap will be required.

Projected Water Fund revenues & expenditures: \$1,286,221

Proposed water rates – no change from last year

Projected Sewer Fund revenues & expenditures: \$152,660

Proposed sewer rates – no change from last year

The Village Manager will present the proposed budget and the Village Board will hear comments at a **public hearing at 7:00pm on Monday, April 3, 2023** in person at 49 State St., Village Court, and via Zoom. Login details available on the agenda posted online or here:

Local Law No. 1 of the year 2023

Village of Brockport, County of Monroe

A local law authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to allow the Village of Brockport to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2023 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes a local government's governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of said governing body.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Brockport, County of Monroe, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2023 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

PLEASE HAVE ALL BRUSH READY FOR PICK UP ON THE SUNDAY EVENING PRECEDING THE LAST WEEK OF THE MONTH.

To ease the process please see information below:

- No contractor generated waste is allowed.
- Do not put leaves in plastic bags. Leaves need to be at the curb in loose piles or in biodegradable bags only.
- Keep limbs under 10ft in length.
- Do not place brush on road, in gutters, or over storm drains.
- No construction debris or building materials.

NOTICE TO BROCKPORT RESIDENTS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that WATER MAIN FLUSHING in the Village of Brockport will take place April 17-20, 2023.

As part of our routine maintenance of the water distribution system in the Village, Department of Public Works crews will be flushing water mains on **April 17-20, 2023**. We do this periodically to clean the mains and flush out sediment accumulations that may settle out in the mains. The flushing will ensure that you have a safe and healthy supply of drinking water.

Flushing operations will be conducted between 9:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. in the following locations on the date indicated:

Monday, April 17, 2023:
NORTH of the canal.
All hydrants, WEST
of North Main Street (NYS Route 19)

Tuesday, April 18, 2023:
NORTH of the canal.
All hydrants EAST of North Main Street.

Wednesday, April 19, 2023:
SOUTH of the canal
All hydrants EAST of Main Street

Thursday, April 20, 2023:
SOUTH of canal
All hydrants WEST of Main Street.

During flushing you may see some cloudiness or color in the water. Please do not use any unnecessary water during this period. The flushing may cause the water to become "cloudy" or "discolored". While the water will be safe to drink, we suggest that you do not wash clothes if you notice the water is discolored. **ANYONE ON A KIDNEY DIALYSIS MACHINE, PLEASE CALL THE SUPERINTENDENTS OFFICE AT THE NUMBER BELOW!**

A RESOLUTION OF THE Village of Brockport ADOPTING THE MONROE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN 2023 UPDATE.

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Village of Brockport; and

WHEREAS the Village of Brockport has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Monroe County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2023 Update in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the Monroe County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2023 Update identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the Village of Brockport from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Board of Trustees demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Monroe County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2023 Update.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Village of Brockport Board of Trustees, NEW YORK, THAT:

Section 1. In accordance with Subdivision 3 of § 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law,, the Village of Brockport adopts the Monroe County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2023 Update. This plan, approved by the community, may be edited or amended after submission for review, but will not require the community to re-adopt any further iterations. This only applies to this specific plan and does not absolve the community from updating the plan in 5 years.
